RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS



Our last Family Rock Mass for the year is being held on Sunday 19th November at 5pm. This Mass is to welcome our incoming Kindergarten families for 2024 and is being led by our current Kindergarten and Year 5 students who will be the buddies for 2024. We are looking forward to this very exciting and joyous mass.

The Season of Giving

The children have been learning much about 'faith in action' this semester particuarly when engaging in support of Catholic Mission and our local outreach to the aged care facilities. These actions reflect our teaching to respond to the call of Jesus as it relates to us in our contemporary society. We teach the children about the principals of 'Catholic Social Teaching', this is a point of difference for us in a Catholic school. We understand the dignity of the human person and know that we are all created in God's image and likeness and therefore are vaulable and worthy of respect.



This is an important discussion point when asking the children to reach out to others who are less fortunate than themselves at this time, as we lead up to Christmas. We learn that we are one human family, and so our practise of love our neighbour must extend to the whole global community not just our own homes!

Our students in K-2 will be talking about ways in which they can raise extra money at home to purchase much needed food items for the Mt Druitt Parish Christmas Hamper appeal. This will be to support the Parish with their collection. A Compass notification will advise of further details. We want the students to do some jobs around the home and earn extra pocket money and be involved in purchasing these items for our hampers. A compass note will be sent listing the items needed from each class.

The children in Years 3-6 will be discussing the needs of the Gethsemane community, homes for the homeless. Gethsemane is a registered charity and public Benevolent Institution. There are two homes we support at Cavendish Lodge in Croydon (22 men and 4 women) and 56 Burt St Rozelle (25 men). Corpus Christi has supported Gethsemane for many years. Thankyou in advance for helping us reach out to others at this busy time in our lives.



We hope you have a safe and happy Wellbeing Week!




