FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Friends,

Small Steps is an education program aimed at raising awareness and improving the recognition of anxiety disorders in children. Approximately one in seven children in Australia have an anxiety disorder. Wayahead Mental Health Association NSW has been delivering seminars in schools for over 20 years. We are excited to welcome them to Corpus Christi on the 5th June to help our parent community understand anxiety and learn strategies they can use to support children experiencing anxiety.

Topics covered in Small Steps:

- The role of fear and anxiety, and when anxiety becomes a disorder
- How anxiety commonly presents in children
- Risk factors for the development of anxiety
- Protective factors that reduce the impact of anxiety
- Treatments for anxiety
- Children's stories of anxiety- strategies and taking 'small steps'
- The anxiety cycle and how we can build resilience to it
- Resources for teachers, parents and carers



On this day, the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles, leading to their empowerment and the growth of the early Church. 
Thank you - Mother's Day Cana Farm Gifts


Students in **K-2** can also log books that have **been read to them** in the Library and their classes.
