FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Friends,

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FROM THE PRINCIPAL

It is true that young children are not able to self-regulate well enough to put necessary limits to using digital media and technologies. It is our role as parents and teachers to do so.

Nevertheless, constructive conversations with children about better digital wellness is a good way to utilise the benefits of digital devices while at the same time understanding the risks related to having too much of them. It is evident now more than ever that digital media and technologies are powerful tools that help us communicate, work and learn more effectively. However these and other benefits brought by digital devices in our lives often come with potential risks and harmful side effects if not handled with care.

ASPIRE

Over the last 6 weeks, a group of children selected from right across the school, got to experience the wonders of Horticulture. Mr Ken Bevan (Dad of Flynn in Year 5) has been volunteering his time every week to support the Garden Club on Tuesday lunchtimes and also teach children about the structure of plants, propagation, root systems, how plants communicate and survive and which plants grow well together. 21 children were given the opportunity to learn the theory and get hands on in the garden. They planted seeds, learned to propagate, discovered the wonders of insects under a microscope and took part in some fantastic discussions around living things. Today the children planted a succulent to take home and they also helped to plant a Bottlebrush tree on the sports field.
